1. The instant petition is preferred under Section 482 of BNSS, seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.211 dated 27.10.2024 under Sections 115(2)/351(2)333/324/190/191(3) of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

2. On 20.01.2025, the following order was passed by the coordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Apprehending their arrest in FIR No.211 dated 27.10.2024 registered for offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 351(2), 333, 324, 190 and 191(3) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Beas, Amritsar; the petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking pre-arrest bail.

Inter alia contends that petitioner No.1 is stated to be empty handed as per prosecution case; petitioner No.2 is stated to be armed with dang but the injury attributed to him is simple in nature; the occasion for filing the anticipatory bail arose on account of non-bailable sections i.e. 351(2) and 333 of BNS, 2023 & the petitioners are willing to join investigation and cooperate therein.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Yuvraj Singh Tiwana, Asstt.

A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 19.02.2025.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 24.01.2025 at 11:00 A.M. in concerned Police Station and join investigation. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal/surety bond(s) to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when further called by Investigating Officer, the petitioners shall join the investigation. They shall abide by the condition(s) enumerated under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Shamsheer Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 20.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

4. Keeping in view the statement made by learned State Counsel, the order dated 20.01.2025 is made absolute. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 482(2) BNSS.

5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed to be an expression of opinion by this Court lest it may prejudice the trial. The learned trial Court is directed to proceed with the trial on its own merits, strictly in accordance with law.
