1. Present petition has been filed praying for granting interim bail to the petitioner for arrangement for a period of three months in case FIR No.203 dated 12.10.2023 under Sections 342, 386, 395, 420, 506, 364-A, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act and Sections 66C & 66D of Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Bahin, District Palwal.
2. Vide order dated 10.02.2025, notice was issued and State was directed to submit a status report regarding health condition of the petitioner. The same was filed on 19.02.2025.
3. Learned State counsel has filed an additional status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Surender Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hathin, District Palwal, which is taken on record. Perusal of the same would show that the petitioner was referred to Neurology Department of Safdarjung Hospital, Delhi, where he was examined by the Specialist and advised medication and Physiotherapy. Though it is stated that the patient was not bed ridden, however, it is apparent from the report



that he has been advised medication by the Specialist after his examination in the Neurology Department.

4. Keeping in view the medical condition of the petitioner as stated above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted interim bail for his treatment w.e.f. 04.04.2025 to 21.04.2025 subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Authorities/ concerned Court at 11:00 A.M. on 22.04.2025. At the time of his release, the Releasing Officer is directed to intimate the petitioner about the date and time of his surrender back to jail.
