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petitioner No.2 is a senior citizen and a household lady and petitioners No.3 & 4 can be represented through their counsel and their presence at the trial is not necessary, therefore, attending trial on each and every date would cause great hardship and inconvenience to them as well as affect their livelihood.

The instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid. However, in view of the ratio laid down by this Court in CRM-M-25963-2023 titled as 'Suresh Kumar and another Vs. The State of Haryana and another' 2023 (2) Law Herald 1498, the personal appearance of petitioners No.2 to 4 before the learned trial Court is ordered to be exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) petitioners No.2 to 4 shall be represented through their counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required;
and
- vi) any other condition, which the trial Court may impose.
