1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 24.08.2012 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Rent Controller, Ludhiana whereby the application under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC filed by the respondent has been allowed.
