The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* with a prayer to appoint a warrant officer from this Court with a direction to search the detainee, namely, Suhani wife of Amrit, who has been immured by respondents No.6 to 9 and after recovering the detainee, to set her at liberty.

On 20.01.2025, on the asking of the Court, the learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State and sought time to file status report. Today, the learned State counsel has filed status report dated 25.01.2025 by way of an affidavit of Sh. Raj Singh, HPS Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaund, District Hisar, on behalf of respondents No.1, 3 & 5-State, which is taken on record. She further refers to the statement of the alleged detainee recorded by the police authorities in which she has stated that she got married with the petitioner on 02.12.2024 and on

27.12.2024, her father, brother and other family members have taken her on the pretext that they will perform her marriage with the petitioner and currently, she is residing with her family and she has expressed her desire to live with the petitioner.

In view of the statement made by the alleged detainee, the present petition is disposed of. The jurisdictional police authorities are directed to record the statements of the private respondents and produce the alleged detainee before the jurisdictional Court within a period of one week. Further, the jurisdictional Magistrate is directed to record the statement of the detainee and thereafter, she may be allowed to go with the petitioner in case she expresses her desire to join his company.
