VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.382 dated 03.10.2020, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 12.02.2021, directions had been issued to the trial court/Area Magistrate to record the statements of the parties with regard to the genuineness of the compromise. The report dated 25.03.2021 is on record as per which out of six accused, the present petition has been filed by only one person Balraj Singh and arrest of one accused Savinder Singh was pending at that stage. Otherwise, the trial Court reported that the compromise had genuinely been arrived at between the petitioner and respondent No.2.

3. The reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State is also on record. The Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place on the case file.

4. It has been stated in the said reply that the petitioner is a habitual offender and many other cases are pending against him, the list of which has been given in paragraph 8 of the reply.

5. Since no one has appeared either on behalf of the petitioner or on behalf of respondent No.2, it appears that the parties are no longer interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
