Status report dated 07.05.2025, filed in the form of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ratia, District Fatehabad, on behalf of State-respondent is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS) the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case FIR as under: -

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 14.02.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. During the course of hearing on 14.02.2025, following order has been passed: -

‘Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in criminal case having FIR No.110 dated 24.04.2024 registered under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 of IPC at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner inter alia submits that no doubt the petitioner is wife of Gurjeet Singh @ Harjeet Singh but she has nothing to do with the transactions as are detailed in the FIR which were entered into between husband of the complainant and aforesaid Gurjeet Singh @ Harjeet Singh. That even in the FIR, it is specifically recorded that amount of Rs.14,00,000/- was paid to Gurjeet Singh @ Harjeet Singh. It is further submitted that the main accused Gurjeet Singh @ Harjeet Singh has surrendered and is now in judicial custody in this very case. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation with the police.

The present petition is resisted by the State counsel as well as counsel for the complainant, both of whom submit that petitioner also actively participated in the fraud worth Rs.21,00,000/- committed against the complainant and her husband. The State counsel further submits that the petitioner is required by the police for the purpose of proper investigation, even if her husband Gurjeet Singh @ Harjeet Singh is arrested by the police.

Counsel for the complainant prays for time to produce the documents relating to transactions in question



having signatures of the present petitioner. Needful be done by the next date of hearing.

Now be listed on 12.05.2025.

In the meantime, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation with the police and in case of arrest, she is directed to be released on interim bail by the IO/Arresting Officer to his own satisfaction till the next date of hearing. The petitioner is to abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.'

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from SI Kanwar Singh, informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 14.02.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 14.02.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS). Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; she will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.

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8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
