The grievance, which propelled the present petitioner to file the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is that the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned, has not taken any cognizance on his complaint bearing No.10331/GC-7/PGD/24, which was referred by the DGP, Punjab.

2. The instant petition is **disposed of**, with a *mandamus* upon the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned, to look into the complaint (*supra*), and thereupon, to take the same to its logical end by passing a speaking order, within a period of 03 months from today, after giving an adequate opportunity to hearing to the parties concerned.
