Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 4, on instructions from Mr. Nitin Yadav, BDPO, Samalkha (Panipat), submits that in view of the approval of exchange order, the respondents will not enforce / implement the ejectment order dated 08.09.2017 passed by respondent No. 4 against the petitioner; in the meanwhile, in case any partition application is filed at the instance of petitioner, the same shall be decided expeditiously and preferably within a period of six months from today; further on the outcome of the partition proceedings, the exchange shall be recorded in the revenue entries within one month thereafter and the exchange deed shall also be executed.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Disposed off** accordingly.

[4] The petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition in case undertaking given the learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 4 is not complied with.
