The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 4 to take appropriate action on the representation dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is an old man who is 74 years of age and they are four brothers and one sister, out of which, his two brothers and one sister died and petitioner along with his wife is living separately. It is further submitted that about 20-25 years ago, they shared land in village Desu Jodha, Tehsil Dabwali, District Sirsa, which was mutually partitioned and documented. Thereafter, the petitioner had no contact with respondent No.6-Mal Singh or his family. Further, private respondent No.6-Mal Singh used to beat the petitioner for not transferring his land on the name of Mal Singh and his son, namely, Gurpreet Singh. Respondent No.6 has also usurped the land of his two deceased brothers by preparing a false Will. On 23.08.2024 at round 01:00 to 02:00 P.M., private respondents along with some other unknown persons came to the petitioner's house with a conspiracy and picked him up by pushing him with an intention to get the release deed executed in favour of respondent No.5 and kidnapped him from his house. Thereafter, he was given injection and he became unconscious and they all took him to the Tehsil office Dabwali as per

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their plan and took his thumb impressions on the sale deeds/release deed already prepared. Thereafter, the petitioner has filed the representation dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3 but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps including grant of any protection to the petitioner in view of the apprehension, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
