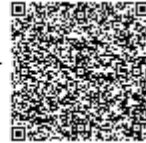

1. Prayer in the instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.60, dated 13.06.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34 of IPC (Section 325 of IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 24.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at, between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 24.01.2025 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 25.02.2025 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

3. Report has since been received from learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, in pursuance of the directions of this Court, wherein it

has been reported that petitioner No.3-Gurmukh Singh is a proclaimed person in the present case. However, in the petition, it has been categorically mentioned that none of the accused-petitioners are proclaimed offenders.

4. In the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
