The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 483 B.N.S.S. (439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 57 dated 27.04.2024 under Sections 21(c), 25, 27-A of NDPS Act 1985, Police Station Division No. 1, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner today in Court, which is taken on record. He submits that Section 29 of the NDPS Act has been added later on.
