1. Petitioner-Kavita has filed this petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.87 dated 18.08.2024, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Women Police Station, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom against respondents No.2 & 3 on the basis of compromise dated 17.07.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that complainant approached the investigating agency that she did not want to take any action against the private respondents.

3. Learned counsel representing State has filed supplementary status report confirming that petitioner has recorded her statement on 04.04.2025 before the investigating officer that she did not want to proceed with the present FIR. Copy of said statement is Annexure R-1/T and copy of compromise is Annexure R-2/T.

4. In the light of aforesaid factual position, the investigating officer can proceed with the cancellation of aforesaid FIR as per law. No further action is required. Therefore, present petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
