1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.200 dated 22.06.2024, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat(Sections 467, 468, 471, 34 of IPC were added later on).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous, as petitioner has passed away in jail due to illness.
