Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 09.01.2025 under Sections 406/420/467 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Panchkula Sector-5, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has already stand compromised and the dispute between the parties has been resolved. He further submits that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant-Bank affirms the factum regarding the compromise.

Vide order dated 05.02.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hardeep Kumar, has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 05.02.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
