1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No. 4 and 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent No. 7.

2. Short reply has been filed by the respondent-State. It is submitted therein and learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has argued that the petitioner has moved two complaints, dated 16.12.2024 and 19.12.2024, against respondent No. 7 with the allegations that he had forcefully removed clothes from her shop and had attempted to take possession of her shop unlawfully. On receipt of aforesaid complaints, due inquiry was initiated by the police but the petitioner refused to join the same. She also refused to get her statement recorded or to produce any evidence in support of her allegations as well as in support of her claim that she was a tenant in the said shop and was paying rent thereof. However, on conducting further inquiry in

the matter, the dispute between the parties was found to be of civil nature. No threat was found to the life and liberty of the petitioner. In view of the same, finding no substance in the allegations levelled by the petitioner against respondent No. 7, both of the said complaints were filed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the aforesaid facts.

4. In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the matter and the petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to avail her legal remedies in accordance with law.
