The petitioners have approached this Court raising a challenge to the impugned orders dated 03.01.2025 and 07.01.2025 (Annexures P-8 and P-8A respectively) passed by the respondent No. 4 vide which the petitioners have been relieved/terminated from the service.

Pursuant to the order dated 14.02.2025 passed by this Court in *CWP-4050-2025* titled as “*Narveer Singh and another versus State of Haryana and others*”, the file of the instant case has been

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received.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has been heard at some length and has been confronted with the certain factual assertions made in the writ petition including reliance placed by him on the Deployment of Contractual Persons Policy, 2022 of which various terms and conditions have been omitted/deleted by the State Government through subsequent instructions/orders.

Faced with the above, learned Counsel for the petitioner(s) seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action, if so advised with better and complete particulars. He further submits that he would have no objection if the hearing of the instant case is pre-poned from the date already fixed and is taken up on Board today itself and the protection already extended vide interim order dated 22.01.2025 is extended for some period so as to enable him to file a fresh petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State has no objection to the same.

With the consent of the parties, hearing of the case is pre-poned from 09.04.2025 and the same is taken up on Board today itself.

The Registry is directed to show the above case in the supplementary list for today.

In view of the aforesaid prayer made by the learned Counsel for the petitioners which is not objected to by the State Counsel, the present writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with



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liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better and complete particulars.

The interim relief granted to the petitioners shall however subsist for a period of four weeks from today, or till filing of the fresh writ petition, whichever is earlier.
