1. The earlier bail petition of the petitioner was dismissed only on 09.12.2024. Without waiting for any further progress in the trial, instant petition has been filed immediately after one month of dismissal of the earlier bail application. No ground is made out to grant the regular bail to the petitioner, that too when the recovery effected in the instant FIR, falls within the ambit of commercial quantity. Moreover, the petitioner is a habitual offender inasmuch as he is involved in two other cases of similar nature besides another case under Arms Act.
