JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India are seeking direction to regularize them as per 1996 and 1999 Policies.

2. The petitioners were appointed from 1986 to 1994 as Water Carriers/Sweepers/Cooks/Malis on part time basis. They served upon respondents a legal notice dated 15.05.2002 seeking regularization under 1996 and 1999 Policies. They filed **CWP-11176-2002** before this Court which was disposed of to decide the legal notice. The respondent on 14.10.2002 rejected their claim on the ground that they do not fulfill the prescribed criteria.

3. This Court vide order dated 22.01.2025 in a bunch of petitions in **CWP-10071-2022** has held that no part time employee shall be regularized as per 1996 policy.

4. Learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that petitioners were appointed on part time basis, however, they continued to work for more than three decades. They had actually worked on full time basis as daily wage worker/contractual. They are entitled to benefit of regularization as per judgments of this Court in *Sanjeev Kumar Versus State of Haryana and Others, 2025 SCC OnLine P&H 2828* and *State of Haryana Versus Jai Bhagwan, 2024 SCC OnLine P&H 15557*.

5. Learned State counsel, faced with aforecited judgments, submits that six petitioners have already retired, three have passed away and five are still in service. Case of all the petitioners would be considered in the light of aforecited judgments. Needful would be done within six months from today.
