Present appeal has been preferred against the judgment of conviction and the order of sentence dated 03.07.2004 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, in case bearing SC No.10 dated 05.03.2004, whereby the appellant was convicted under Sections 307 & 452 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a maximum period of three years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- along with default mechanism.
