1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.24 dated 06.04.2024 under Sections 147/148/149/323/427/308 of IPC (Sections 427/308 of IPC deleted later on) registered at Police Station IT Park, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. On 03.02.2025, the following order was passed:-

'This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS seeking quashing of FIR No.24 dated 06.04.2024 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 427, 308 IPC (Sections 308 and 427 IPC deleted later on) at Police Station IT Park, Chandigarh, on the basis of compromise dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-3) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Notice of motion for 03.03.2025.

At this stage, on asking of the Court, Manish Bansal, P.P., U.T. Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 – State and Ms. Indu Bala, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and files Memorandum of Appearance, which is taken on record.

Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day. Service is complete.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any



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other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 03.03.2025.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.'

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466** and **Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No.24 dated 06.04.2024 under Sections 147/148/149/323/427/308 of IPC (Sections 427/308 of IPC deleted later on) registered at Police Station IT Park, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, qua the petitioners.
