1. Instant appeal has been preferred against the judgment of conviction dated 08.12.2003 and order of sentence dated 09.12.2003, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal, whereby appellant was convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of seven years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- under Section 376 IPC and in default of payment of fine to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year.

2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the appellant, notice was ordered to be issued to the appellant. As per office report, notice issued to the appellant has been received back with the report that he has expired.

3. In view of the above, present appeal is disposed of being abated.
