1. Present petition has been filed praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.126, dated 16.11.2024, under Sections 109, 118(1), 126(2), 351(3), 61(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.
