1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to grant the pay scale of Rs.1200-2040 w.e.f. the date of regularisation of their services to the post of Pump Attendant.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the petitioners were claiming technical pay scale that was not being granted to them on account of not possessing the ITI qualification as prescribed without disputing that the petitioners were performing the duties against technical sanctioned posts. He contends that the petitioners would now be entitled to the said benefits in view of the subsequent judgment dated 25.03.2025 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in **CWP-11710-2014** titled as '**Sarbans Singh and others** Vs. **State of Haryana and others**' and



other connected case(s). He contends that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition so as to file a detailed representation to respondent No.4-The Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division, Yamuna Nagar (Sub-Division No.2, Jagadhari, Distt. Yamuna Nagar) and that in the event of the petitioners submitting such a representation, the same be decided expeditiously and in accordance with law and after taking note of the judgment of the Division Bench in the matter of *Sarbans Singh and others (supra)*.

3. Learned State counsel does not have any serious objection to the same.

4. The present writ petition is accordingly ***disposed of*** at this stage on the request of learned counsel for the petitioners and without opining on the merits with liberty to the petitioners to submit a representation to respondent No.4 claiming the technical pay scale within a period of 6 months from today.

5. Needless to mention that in the event of submitting such a representation, the competent authority-respondent No.4-The Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division, Yamuna Nagar (Sub-Division No.2, Jagadhari, Distt. Yamuna Nagar) shall take a decision thereon and pass a speaking order within a further period of 03 months.

6. In the event of the petitioners being found entitled to the benefits as asked for in view of the law including the judgment of the Division Bench in the matter of *Sarbans Singh and others (supra)*, the



requisite benefits shall be released to them within a further period of 02 months, failing which, they shall be entitled to the interest @6% per annum from passing of the judgment till its final disbursement.

7. **Disposed of in above terms.**
