On 19.02.2025, a coordinate Bench had passed the following order:

Fresh notice be issued to unserved respondent No.2 on address to be supplied by the petitioners.

Steps be also taken to implead the legal representatives of deceased-respondent No.1.

List on 30.07.2025.”

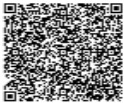
2. On 30.07.2025, this Court passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for some time to comply with the order dated 19.02.2025.

Adjourned to 24.09.2025.

In case of non-compliance, the interim order dated 15.11.2017 shall stand vacated.”

3. Admittedly, till date, the order dated 19.02.2025 has not been complied with.
