NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to undertake immediate and necessary measures to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from the private respondents and to take appropriate legal action against private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner restricts his prayer qua relief of protection of life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8. He further submits that petitioner has submitted a representation dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, which is still pending consideration. He submits that petitioner would be satisfied, if

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the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3-State.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
