For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and
with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the date of hearing is
preponed and the writ petition is taken on Board today itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had
been allotted residential Plot No.886 in Sector-52, Gurugram, on 15.09.2003
and he had paid the entire amount at that time, but the possession of the plot

was not handed over to him. The petitioner later approached this Court by preferring CWP No.5750 of 2019, which was disposed of vide order dated 05.03.2019 (Annexure P-10), with direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner for allotment of an alternative plot. An alternative plot was subsequently allotted to the petitioner in the year 2024. The petitioner is now claiming interest for the delay in possession of the plot as he had deposited the entire amount in the year 2003 as per the terms and conditions of the allotment. He further submits that the petitioner had sent a representation dated 06.12.2024 (Annexure P-19) to the respondents and the petition be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the said representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner.

2. Heard.

3. This petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide representation dated 06.12.2024 (Annexure P-19) in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
