State of Punjab and another Vs. Harjinder Singh

Learned State counsel has placed copy of memo dated
24.1.2025 received from Department of Home Affairs, Home-3 Branch,
Govt. of Punjab, addressed to the Director General of Punjab, Chandigarh
in which it has been mentioned as under:

“With reference to your office letter No.170/LA-8, dated, Chandigarh
10.01.2025 on the subjected cited above.

2. It is informed that since the litigation is more than two decades old, and
the cause of action had arisen more than three decades ago when the official
remained willfully absent from duty.
3. There appears to be nothing in the judgment (s) that can become a
precedent for future cases in which disciplinary action is taken against any
official. These are ‘judgment in personam’ rather than “judgment in rem”.
4. Therefore, the Department may give its consent for withdrawal of the
RSA on the condition that the plaintiff/respondent shall not be entitled to any
financial benefits for the period for which he remained absent from duty. This
submission may be made before the Permanent Lok Adalat of the Hon’ble
High Court.”

The Director General of Punjab (Litigation Branch) has
further endorsed the said letter to learned State counsel and SSP Faridkot
for further necessary action.

Since the department of Home affairs has already given
consent for withdrawal of the present appeal with the condition that

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the plaintiff-respondent shall not be entitled to any financial benefit for the period for which he remained absent and the same has been further endorsed by ADGP Punjab, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
