1. Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.77 dated 24.03.2024, under Sections 120-B, 285, 506 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar along with consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) arrived at between petitioner and respondent No.2.
2. Learned counsel for the complainant has reiterated that there is no compromise in the present case from his behalf as contended by learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel has submitted that even otherwise the petition has been filed on the basis of partial compromise.
4. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today and same was the position on the last date of hearing also. It appears that petitioner as well as his counsel are not interested in pursuing the matter any further.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
