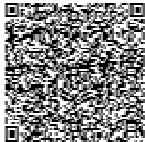

1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C./528 of the BNSS, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.0147 dated 20.11.2021 registered under Sections 3 & 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Sections 420, 498-A, 212 and 34 IPC at Women Police Station, Faridabad, on the basis of compromise between the parties.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from L/I Usha, submits that there are total 08 accused persons in the aforesaid FIR and challan has been presented against 04 and 04 have been declared as proclaimed persons. Present petition has been filed on behalf of 03 accused persons only. She further submits that even the victim (wife) has not been impleaded as party-respondent in the present petition. She



submits that in view of the Division Bench judgment of this Court in ***Rakesh Das v. State of Haryana, 2024(4) Law Herald 3141***, petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of partial compromise, is not maintainable.

3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of being not maintainable. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file fresh petition on the same cause of action on behalf of all the accused-persons at an appropriate stage.
