The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.3 dated 09.01.2020 registered under Sections 420, 120-B, 506 IPC, 1860 at P.S. Rureke Kalan District Barnala on the basis of compromise as well as on merits.

It is the case of the petitioner that absolutely no offence whatsoever is made out. In fact, the Investigating Agency had submitted a cancellation report in which the complainant was asked to appear but he chosen not to do so because of which the said Court sent the matter back for further investigation.

The learned State counsel does not deny the fact that a cancellation report had been submitted but the complainant had chosen not to appear before the Court because of which the said Court sent the matter back for further investigation.

In view of the submissions made the Investigating Agency is directed to conclude the investigation within a period of four weeks from

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the date of receipt of a copy of this order and submit a report to the concerned Magistrate. The said Court shall thereafter in case the cancellation report submitted once again adjudicate upon the same after serving a notice upon the complainant. In case, the complainant chooses not to appear before the concerned Court, the said Court may proceed in accordance with law after examining the report submitted before it.

In case a report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. is submitted inculcating the petitioner, she is at liberty to approach this Court once again by way of an appropriate petition for quashing of the FIR.
