By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance to the order dated 11.03.2025, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 11.03.2025, following order had been passed: -

*“Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bikramjit Singh through pairvi report, submits that the petitioners have not joined the investigation.*



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- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks one more opportunity for the petitioner to join the investigation.*
- 3. In the interest of justice, the petitioners are hereby directed to join investigation on or before 18.03.2025 and in the event of their arrest, they are ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.*
- 4. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present along with record on the next date of hearing.*
- 5. No further opportunity for this purpose shall be granted.*
- 6. List on 25.03.2025.”*

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from ASI Bikramjeet Singh informs the Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 11.03.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 11.03.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioners are directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioners; they will not tamper with the



evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
