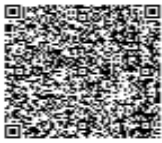

By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent to grant the possession of the residential plot allotted to the petitioner vide allotment letter dated 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) under oustee policy and further direct the respondent to decide the representation dated 30.12.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already made a representation dated 30.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the competent authority for redressal of its grievances, but no action has been



taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with its concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said application.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-HSVP and submits that the said representation/application shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 (competent authority), to look into the pending representation/application dated 30.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
