1. The present civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the orders dated 25.11.2021 & 29.12.2021 (Annexures P-6 to P-8, respectively).

2. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the controversy involved in the present case is squarely covered by the judgment rendered by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.27725 of 2012 titled as '**Punjab State Warehousing Corporation Field Employees Union Vs. Union of India & others**' decided on 14.05.2025.

3. Mr. Satyam Tandon, Advocate for respondents No.2 to 4 submits that the claim of the petitioner would be decided in terms of the policy/standard operating procedure dated 22.10.2021 and letter dated 30.05.2022. Until the said claim is decided by the authorities concerned afresh on the representation made by the petitioner, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.

4. In view of the discussion above, the present petition is disposed of accordingly in terms of **CWP No.27725 of 2012** titled as ***Punjab State Warehousing Corporation Field Employees Union (supra)***.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
