Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.0246 dated 05.12.2024, registered under Sections 117(2), 115(2), 351(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 (Section 303(2) of BNS added later on vide GD No.43 dated 18.12.2024), registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.
2. By virtue of order dated 28.01.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karnail Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
