1. Instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) has been preferred by the petitioner seeking direction to official respondents for conducting fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No. 40 dated 03.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 302, 120-B, 427, IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) by some senior official not below the rank of Superintendent of Police or some independent agency.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner happens to be complainant in the case FIR (Annexure P-1). Feeling aggrieved by the improper investigation, petitioner



had moved representation dated 17.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, Punjab (respondent No.3) but till date no action thereon has been taken. She submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied, if, appropriate directions are accorded to respondent No.3 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 17.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of Court, Mr. Rajender Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State and submits that the representation will be considered and disposed of in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

5. Heard.

6. After considering the rival contentions and perusing the averments and also the limited request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and dispose of representation dated 17.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner.
