1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner has been released the salary and with respect to his claim in relation to communication dated 04.11.2024, a speaking order shall be passed within two weeks from today.
2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in such eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
