1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of result dated 23.08.2003 (Annexure P-5) with respect to Advertisement No.1/2003 whereby posts of Sub Inspector of Police were advertised.

2. Haryana Staff Selection Commission vide Advertisement No.1/2003 invited applications for 100 posts of Sub Inspector of Police. The petitioner pursuant to aforesaid advertisement applied for the said post. He qualified written test and was shortlisted for physical test which was conducted from 18.08.2003 to 22.08.2003. The respondent declared result on 25.08.2003 wherein name of petitioner did not figure.

3. As per reply, the petitioner did not qualify 100m/800m race and long jump event. He was not found physically fit.

4. The selection process commenced and concluded in 2003. Claim of petitioner does not seem to be absolute, clean and undisputed. A

period of 22 years has passed away. All the selected candidates must have joined and further promoted.

5. In view of judgment of Hon’ble Supreme Court in ***‘Sivanandan C.T. and Others v. High Court of Kerala and Others’***, ***2023 SCC OnLine SC 994***, no interference at this stage is warranted.
6. Dismissed.
7. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
