JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. Through instant application under Section 11(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short '**1996 Act**'), the applicant is seeking appointment of an Arbitrator.

2. On 22.04.2025, Ms. Ridhi Bansal, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent No.1. Respondent No.3 has already passed away. Respondent Nos.1 and 2 are legal representatives of respondent No.3. On 04.07.2025, Ms. Shreya Bublani, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 and sought time to get instructions from respondent Nos.2 and 3. Respondent No.1 is one of legal representatives of respondent No.3. Respondent No.2 is father of respondent No.1. It means respondent Nos.1 and 2 are family members. It appears that despite granting opportunities, the respondents have opted to abstain from joining the proceedings before this



Court. The matter cannot be kept pending for an indefinite period especially when the prayer in the application is confined to appointment of an Arbitrator who ultimately would adjudicate rights and liabilities of the parties. Thus, this Court is left with no other option except to adjudicate the case on the basis of available record.

3. The parties entered into arbitration agreements. A dispute erupted between the parties. The applicant served notice upon the respondent seeking resolution of dispute through Arbitral Tribunal but to no avail.

4. Conditions to invoke power conferred by Section 11(6) of 1996 Act stand satisfied, thus, I hereby appoint a Sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the parties.

5. Mr. Ravinder Malik, Advocate, residing at A-4, Shalimar Enclave, Dhakoli, Zirakpur, District Mohali, Punjab, Mobile Nos.9417430742 & 9738000012 is hereby appointed as a Sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the parties, subject to compliance of statutory requirements. The learned Arbitrator is requested to comply with mandate of Section 12 of 1996 Act before proceeding further.

6. The parties at the first instance will appear before the Arbitrator on 13.08.2025 at 10:00 AM and thereafter, as directed by learned Arbitrator.

7. The Arbitrator shall be paid fee in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the 1996 Act, as amended.

8. The Arbitrator is requested to complete the proceedings as per time limit specified under Section 29-A of the 1996 Act.



9. Needless to mention, parties would be at liberty to raise all the claims/defences/counter claims/pleas before the Arbitrator. Any observation made hereinabove will not be binding on the learned Arbitrator.
