1. The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of orders dated 04.05.2023 (Annexure P-22) and dated 14.07.2023 (Annexure P-23) vide which the petitioner has been declared a 'Proclaimed Person', in complaint case NACT No.3346 dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-2).

2. On 05.02.2024, the following order was passed:

“Contentends, inter alia, that although petitioner was declared as aproclaimed person twice, vide impugned orders dated 04.05.2023 &14.07.2023 (P-22 & P-23), respectively by the Court of competentjurisdiction; but till date, there is no FIR registered against him underSection 174-A, IPC and he is ready to join the proceedings before learnedtrial Court.

Mr. Vivek Singla, APP, UT, Chandigarh, who is present in theCourt, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and seeks time to haveinstructions and/or file written response in the matter.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the proceedings within two weeks from today after moving an appropriate application before learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate and he be released on interim bail, in the present case, till the next date of hearing on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that in deference to the aforementioned order, petitioner has surrendered and has since been released on interim bail. He further states that the trial is at its fag end.
4. In view of the above, no further orders are called for.
5. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
