Reply dated 09.05.2025 in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, HSEB, Panipat, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

During the course of submissions, Mr. Niranjana Lal, Mining Officer, Department of Mines and Geology, Panipat, has stated at bar that if the petitioner deposits a penalty of Rs.37,500/- with the department, the department will release the vehicle in question bearing No. HR58-D-5532 to the petitioner subject to the outcome of the case.
