The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner for seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to consider the petitioner for the post of Group 'D' as per advertisement (Annexure P-1) under their respective category.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2- Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commissioner is directed to decide the representation dated 19.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) as well as legal notice dated 15.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) and the grievance espoused by the



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petitioner therein by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondents and submits she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and the respondent No.2- Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commissioner, is directed to decide the representation dated 19.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) as well as legal notice dated 15.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
