JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release his retiral dues.
2. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Advocate submits that as per her instructions, all the dues of the petitioner stand paid.
3. There was no representation of the petitioner on 31.07.2024. Even today, there is no representation of the petitioner.



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4. The matter is pending before this Court since 2000. It appears that with the efflux of time the petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the matter.
5. In view of the above, the Court is left with no other option except to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.
6. Dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to petitioner to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
