1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.161 dated 31.12.2024 under Sections 333/115(2)/190/191(3) of BNS, 2023 (Section 117(1) of BNS, 2023 was added later on), registered at Police Station Shambu, Patiala, District Patiala.

2. Vide order dated 31.01.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Bhan Singh has stated that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more

required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 31.01.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
