The instant petition is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88 dated 18.05.2024 under Sections 380, 408 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that another petition i.e. CRM-M-1416-2025 filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of the FIR in question stands allowed by this Court, wherein the FIR has been quashed on the basis of compromise dated 26.12.2024 arrived at between the parties. In view of the same, nothing survives in the instant petition.
3. In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
