1. At the very outset, while placing reliance upon an order dated 27.02.2025, passed in CWP-16778-2022 and connected petitions, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similar writ petitions preferred by the petitioner-corporation, have already been disposed of as not pressed any further, as the petitioner-corporation has decided to release the benefit in favour of the employees. The relevant part of the said order is extracted hereinafter:-

“1. By this common order, 20 writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the Resolution dated 30.10.2024 passed by the petitioners wherein, it has already been decided to release the benefit in favour of the employees, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of. ”

2. In view of the aforesaid order, and the submissions, as made

by learned counsel for the petitioner-corporation, the instant petitions are

also **disposed of**, in the same terms.
