The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of order dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-7) passed by the learned trial Court, whereby, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.08.2022 has been cancelled and further non-bailable warrants of arrest are issued in case bearing FIR No.138 dated 04.07.2022 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

The learned State counsel at the very outset submits that the present petition is not maintainable as the petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail on 29.08.2022 by the learned trial Court with a condition that the same shall be deemed to be cancelled on receipt of report of Forensic Science Laboratory if the quantity involved in the present case falls within the ambit of commercial quantity. The report of the Chemical Examiner was received which clearly indicates that the recovered contraband from the petitioner falls within the commercial quantity, as such, the learned trial Court vide impugned order

dated 22.01.2025 cancelled the interim bail of the petitioner.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and submits that the petitioner would surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of two weeks from today.
