This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.4 to re-issue the passport of the petitioner.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that in case F.I.R. No.21, dated 13.01.2023, under Sections 170, 419, 420, 465, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered against the petitioner, at Police Station Derabassi, District SAS Nagar, charges have already been framed against the petitioner and the trial is pending.

2.1 Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned Court, where the trial in case F.I.R. No.21, dated 13.01.2023, under Sections 170, 419, 420, 465, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered against



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the petitioner, at Police Station Derabassi, District SAS Nagar; is pending against the petitioner and to seek permission to depart from India in terms of the notification No.570(E), dated 25.08.1993, issued by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.

3. In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with the liberty aforesaid.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall stand closed.
