Petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated 28.11.2024, whereby, learned Special Court, Fazilka has allowed the application filed by respondent No.2 by directing to preserve the call details of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that he is being aggrieved by order dated 28.11.2024 for the reason that if his call details as directed by learned Court are preserved, his privacy will be disturbed and being a public servant, his privacy should not be disclosed to anyone for a longer time, which would result in causing hindrance in discharging of his public duties. He relies upon the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Suresh Kumar vs. Union of India, 2015(3) RCR (Criminal) 340.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice of behalf of the State. He has submitted that the call details preserved for the relevant time would only be used and privacy of the petitioner would not be disturbed.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of by ensuring that only the relevant call details of the petitioner would be made available and not for the time which has no concern with the case in hand.
