1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.261 dated 16.07.2023, under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 of IPC registered at Police Station City, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 12.10.2023 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 22.04.2024 :-

“By way of this petition, prayer is made to quash FIR No.261 dated 16.07.2023, under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 of IPC registered at Police Station City, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur and all the consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR on the basis of compromise deed dated 12.10.2023 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Baljinder Singh DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

Ms. Anmol Thakur, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2, files his vakalatnama and admits the factum of compromise.

In view of the above, parties are directed to appear before learned Trial Court/Area Magistrate for making the statements



regarding the compromise on or before 10.05.2024 or any other date which may be fixed by the trial Court for getting the statements recorded. Learned Magistrate shall report to this Court regarding the genuineness of the compromise; number of accused involved; the fact that all the aggrieved parties are party to the compromise, that no accused is absconding/P.O. Statement of Investigating Officer shall also be recorded by the said Magistrate to the effect that no other accused or aggrieved person is involved.
Adjourned to 10.07.2024."

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.
4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 46***, and ***Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63*** and Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.261 dated 16.07.2023, under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 of IPC registered at Police Station City, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioner.
